

RIDE-ALONG RELEASE FORM

Know all men by these presents, that I _____ being over the age of twenty-one, for and in consideration of permission and authorization by the Mobile Police Department for me to accompany and ride with the City of Mobile Police officers in the course of their regular duties for the purpose observation, do hereby release and discharge by these presents do for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, release and forever discharge the City of Mobile, its agents, servants and employees and their heirs, successors, executors, administrators and assigns of and from any and all claims, demands, damages, actions, causes of action, or suits at law or in equity of whatever kind or nature for or because of any matter or thing done, omitted or suffered to be done prior to and including the date of the execution of this release or in the future on accounting of any damages both to person or property arising out of my accompanying and/or riding with Mobile Police officers during their regular tour of duty on _____.

I, further hereby agree to hold the City of Mobile, its agents, servants and employees and their successors, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns harmless from any and all such claims, suits, demands, personal injury or property damage arising in the future from my accompanying police officers and to indemnify, reimburse, or make good any loss, damage, or cost that the Mobile Police Department, officers of the Mobile Police Department, or the City of Mobile may have to pay if any litigation arises from my accompanying and/or riding with Mobile Police officers.

I, the undersigned, have read this release and understand all of its terms. I execute it voluntarily and with full knowledge that it means that I give up all rights concerning any claims against the City of Mobile, which I may have now or in the future out of my accompanying and/or riding with Mobile Police officers during their regular tour of duty.

The civilian ride-along program is not designed to be a training program for future employment. Citizens accompany officers for observation only. Shift supervisors will select the officer the citizen rides with. *No relatives, boyfriends, girlfriends will be allowed to ride with affected officer.* Ride-Along will be required to wear business attire.
