About Project THRIVE and Youth Violence Prevention (YVP)

Project THRIVE stands for Trauma Healing and Resiliency in the Wake of Violent Events. It's mission is to reduce violence and recidivism all while creating a trauma-informed community. Being trauma-informed looks at individuals from the lens of what happened to you rather than what's wrong with you.

As only one aspect of a four-corner approach in **Operation Echo Stop** (reducing the sound of gunfire in our city), **Youth Violence Prevention** relies on collaborating with community partners and stakeholders, and engaging youth and families.

This summer, the **City of Mobile Police Department Office of Strategic Initiatives** and partnering agencies of **Project THRIVE** will host a series of community engagement events centered around youth violence prevention.
